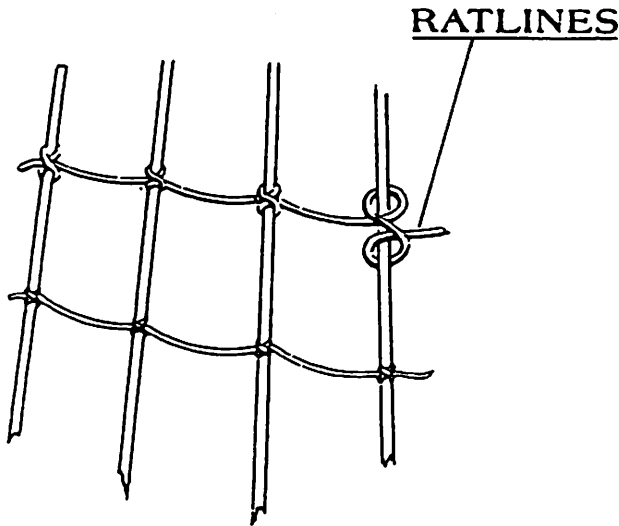
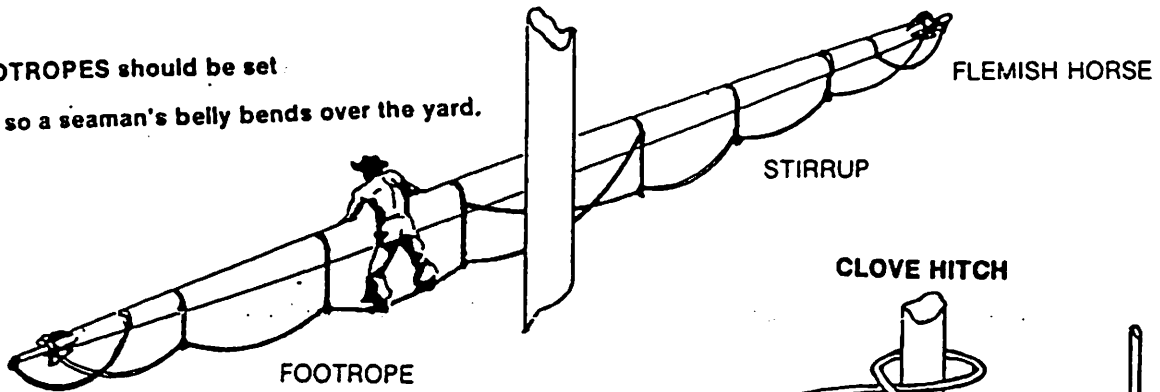

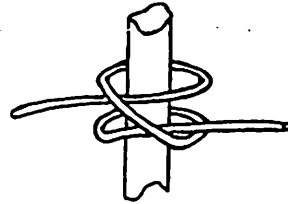
FOOTROPES should be set
so a seaman's belly bends over the yard.



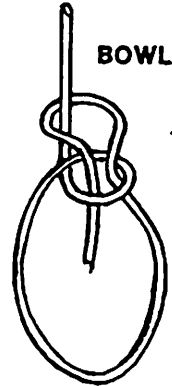
TIE RATLINES WITH CLOVE HITCHES

On a real ship the ends of the ratlines would be eye spliced and fashed to the shroud

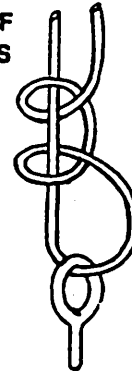
CLOVE HITCH

SLIP KNOT

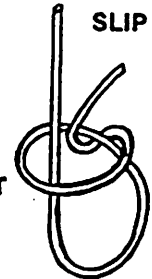
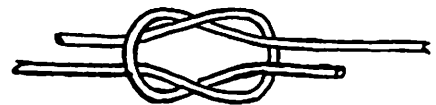
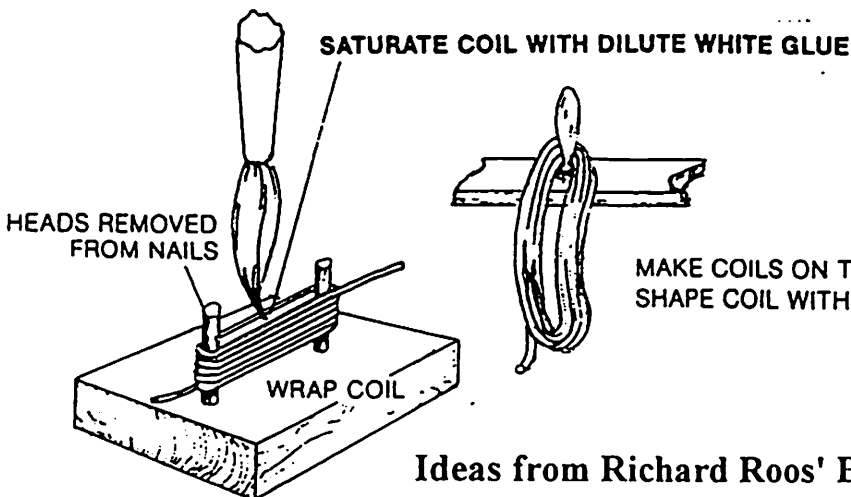


FIGURE 8 KNOT (STOPPER)
